

**YORK USA  
MEETING MINUTES  
AUGUST 12, 2009**

The meeting was called to order 7:29 p.m. by Steve Clever, President.

**EXECUTIVE BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT:** Steve Clever, President, Cindy Mullin, Vice President of Recreation, Louise Batory, Secretary, Tim Herman, Treasurer, At Large Members: Al Chesnavage, and Ray Snyder

**MEETING MINUTES:** Steve reviewed the meeting minutes for July. A correction to the minutes was noted that Red Lion's exception request was for one boy and one girl. A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes as corrected. All ayes.

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** Tim Herman distributed and reviewed a copy of the July treasurer's report. A motion was made and seconded to approve the report. All ayes. He distributed and reviewed a copy of the annual budget. A motion was made and seconded to approve the report. Both reports are on file in the League office.

**WEB-MASTER REPORT:** Ray Snyder reported that he will be publishing the information about the Uniroyal program on the web-site.

**EXECUTIVE BOARD REPORT:**

**Number of Games Scheduled:** Steve reported that the Games Commissioner was having trouble scheduling the same number of games for age brackets that had an odd number of teams. He stated that because the schedules needed to be developed, the Executive Board made the decision to have those age brackets, which total ten, play eight games. He commented that all the other age brackets will play seven games. Steve added that some teams may be scheduled to play on their off day to accommodate the schedules.

**Green Card:** Steve stated that a low number of green cards are being turned in at the end of the season. He announced that the Board decided one representative from each club will be responsible for collecting the cards and for sending them into the office and must be received no later than one month after the season or by the next League meeting. He commented that the cards should be turned in to assist in insurance coverage. Steve stated that the Executive Board suggests a \$25.00 fine for each green card that is not turned in. Discussion was held. A motion was made and seconded to issue a fine of \$15.00 for each green card that is not turned in. All ayes.

A motion was made and seconded to approve the request. All ayes.

**Courses:** John Fellenbaum announced that Hanover is planning a D & E course. He instructed everyone to check the web-site for details and updates.

**Mandatory Coach's Meeting:** John announced that U6 coaches, U8 coaches and club presidents will be meeting just prior to the mandatory coaches meeting 6:15 p.m. on August 20 at the Holidayome. He shared a few of the topics that will be discussed at the meeting.

**Clinics:** John announced that on Saturday NEYSA will be hosting a clinic for U8/10 coaches at PP&L to begin at 9:00 a.m. and run until 10:30 a.m. He also announced a clinic that is being held on August 29<sup>th</sup> at York Township Park field #2, hosted by Dallastown for U6/8 coaches. He added that the clinic will begin at 10:00 a.m. and the contact coordinator is Eric Pierce.

Symposium: John shared that the Post Alliance Symposium at Emmaculata College will be held August 30, 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

ODP: John shared that the ODP tryout schedule for U12 will be published on the EPYSA web-site.
